Since 1995, the Northeastern New York Komen Affiliate has granted over \$650,000 to non-duplicative breast cancer programs for the medically underserved in the Affiliate's service area (i.e., upstate New York counties). Up to 75% of net revenues raised through the Komen Albany Race for the Cure® and other events and activities fund these programs. A minimum of 25% of net revenues support the Susan G. Komen Breast Cancer Foundation Award and Research Grant Program.
